

# Gail (aka Nightsongs)



## Materials:

1 skein of Hand Maiden Sea silk  
4.5mm needles

I used fingering weight yarn, but you can use any weight you desire. The “lacyness” of this shawl will depend on the needle size, the bigger the needles, the more lacy your shawl will be.

You can make this shawl as long or short as you want. Remember that the amounts of yarn required will change depending on the shawl size and/or yarn choice.

The one I knit has 7 pattern repeats. You can keep on knitting for as long as you like/have yarn.

## Gauge? Swatch?

Lets just skip this, shall we?

## Instructions:

Cast on 4 stitches and work 2 rows in garter st.. The border consists of two stitches on either side worked in garter st – **those stitches are not shown in the charts**. Wrong side rows of the chart are purled.

On the next RS row (first row on the chart) you will do:

2st (border),2YO, 2st (border)

Keep working following the first chart until the desired length.
